

Gold Medal of Achievement Staff Aides

The Waco Section Royal Rangers Sectional Staff has decided to include all boys that have earned their Gold Medal of Achievement to serve as Sectional Staff Aides. This entitles these boys to attend our sectional staff meetings and round tables; however, these boys will not be entitled to wear the sectional staff patch. At any sectional event the section will have special arm bands made that have the sectional staff patch on the arm band and this will designate them as Sectional Staff Aides.

To be able to become a Sectional Staff Aide, you must have earned your Gold Medal of Achievement, be a born again believer, live in or attend church in the Waco Section, have completed the Gold Medal of Achievement Staff Aides Application, and have the recommendation of your Senior Commander.


Once you have completed the above process your application must be sent to the Sectional Royal Rangers Staff, for them to look over and to make sure that the application has been completed. Once the process is complete and you become a Sectional Staff Aide, a congratulatory letter will be sent to you welcoming you as a Sectional Staff Aide.

This position should not be taken lightly. You will be in the spotlight, held as an example before the other boys. You will be the voice for the boys to the Sectional Staff at the staff meetings and the voice of the boys to the commanders and staff at the round tables. You will be expected to assist the sectional staff in all duties assigned at sectional events and other Royal Rangers events. You are in a leadership role, when you serve as a Sectional Staff Aide. Therefore, you should be able to show the qualities of a good leader. A good leader is there to serve. Jesus tells us in the book of Matthew chapter 20 verse 26, 27, and 28 "Not so with you. Instead, whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant, and whoever wants to be first must be your slave-- just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many." Jesus, the greatest leader and example we have came to this earth to serve others not to be served, same with you as a young man. In this staff aides position you are here to serve others, not to be served.
